Poker tournament and screen shots! Before making your deposit for a poker tournament it would be wise to see some screen shots of the poker room in which you will be playing. So that you have a feel of how the room you play will eventually look. However, if you are going to pay to play in a site that you are most used to, you may not require such.

[Poker tournament](#) and re-buys! Some tournaments allow re-buys whereas others do not. You need to understand that if the tourney is a re-buy tourney and if in the middle of the game you want to go all-in and buy some more stakes you need to click on the re-buy button and make the required payment to get the stakes. If the poker tournament is not a re-buy game you will not have the re-buy option in the window or that button will be inactive.

Poker tournament and bonuses! Bonuses are given for those that are already members or for people who are signing up new to play the game in a poker site. Bonuses can be play money or a limited period waiver of membership fee. Sometime bonuses are also given for players who keep winning in a poker tournament to keep them encouraged to go to the next stage.

Poker tournament and Schedules! There are some comical events when a player would have registered for a tournament and when they log in to play, the game would have been over. This is because such players would not have looked in to the schedule for the tournament. Some sites send remainder e-mails, while all sites do not do that. Noting down the event timing is very important to avoid missing out on events.
