Memphis is a strategically located city on the Mississippi River, across from the states of Mississippi and Arkansas. It is an ideal place to start your business with its extensive transportation links, moderate climate, hospitality and famous cultural attractions. Memphis' population of 670,000 makes it the largest city in the region, and second largest metropolitan area after Nashville, Tn. Memphis is known as a center of rhythm and blues musicians such as B.B. King. He played on Beale St. in Memphis, now location of the tourist attraction, the Beal St. Club. Of course Memphis is the home of Graceland, the mansion and memorial of Elvis Presley, the king of rock 'n roll.

Extensive highways connect Memphis to the surrounding region, including I-40 that loops about the city and continues west. The city also has excellent water resources, being located over the Memphis aquifer. There are four distinct seasons, with mild winters, although there can be periods of sudden cold.

Memphis is a ideal regional hub for businesses, with connections locally and internationally. Its cargo airport is known as the world's largest and the hub center for the national and international goods shipper, FedEx. Memphis is also a railroad center, with two major rail passenger stations, and east-west rail crossings of the Mississippi River. The Memphis River port is one of the largest in the nation, known as the International Port of Memphis and extending into Arkansas as well.

Rounding out the attractions of the city, it is the home of the Memphis Motorsports Park, and the National Basketball Association team, the Memphis Grizzlies.

In the early phases of your business, it is certainly cheaper and often more convenient to set up a Memphis virtual office. When you are in town, you have a professional conference room you can use to meet them, and a place where you can also occasionally work alone with all the office facilities you need. You can use the free Internet, fax, copier and phone facilities, including unlimited long distance calls. Virtual offices can be had for as little as \$75-a-month, while private offices can be as little as \$100-a-month.
