

Messages on Hold

All business is getting better, and things are getting busier around the office. People have already decided that we need to upgrade your phone message system but now, there seems to be so much to consider when you look at the various on hold messaging systems that you are not sure which way to go. We have some tips to help you make that right choice about the supplier. All companies may refer to services in similar terms, but the meaning may not at all be the same. For example- one company may promise to give you 12 messages. By this what they may mean is 12 messages of about one paragraph each. Some other company promising to deliver 12 messages may be referring to 12 5-minute on hold productions with music. We will also want to ask about the quality of the message before you sign the agreement. The Demos and samples are always made to ensure the company looks good.

Try to find out if the actual voice used will be as good as the demo version. We may also want to find out if your advertising on hold messages can be put into Spanish, or another language, too, if you have that language in your area. Every minute or two that you have with a client on hold could make a large impact on them - if the message is targeted and compelling. Do ask for sample messages from the on hold advertising agency of messages that they have done for similar businesses. We want our message to be precise, without fluff, and done in such a way to lead them to ask about it when they do get through. Some times, audio-marketing companies may offer package deals of so many messages for so much within a year's time. It is excellent if your company needs a lot of different messages in a year, but if you have a small company, you might be able to save by going with a smaller package deal. And also, find out if you can get your new on hold music and messages by easily downloading the new selections.

All digital equipment is better - mainly because it is more durable and has no moving parts, it does cost more initially but will pay for itself over time. All it will also work immediately after power is restored from an outage. Some specialized CD players developed for 24X7X265 use are always an alternative if your budget does not immediately allow for a digital option. Try to consider here are whether to rent it or buy it. And if you buy, be sure to get the proper warranties. People strongly recommend you purchase your hardware from the same company which provides the production as you'll have a single contact in the event of a problem.
