Keep your condoms stored in a cool, dry area away from sunlight (that means don't keep it in your wallet for weeks at a time). Doing all this will ensure that your intimacy will be protected, and protected well, which means one less thing to have to worry about, which is always a good thing. And that's how to put on a condom!
